I then would send my designs to the head designer to be approved and potentially be put into the LPD collection, for then to be sold on their website, trade shows and client meetings. I helped with day-to-day duties and errands of taking fabrics to the laundrette, ironing fabrics, cutting and mounting fabric and paper designs, and collecting and delivering post and parcels from the post office and to other companies. I also attended a client meeting with management to showcase designs.
